SPECIFIC TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. The Championship

- a) The Championship shall be open to men, who are members of an affiliated club in Wales.
- b) A team shall consist of five players. All matches shall be played off scratch. The team winning three or more games shall be the winner and enter the next round. Individual games shall be played to a conclusion until the overall result of the match is ensured. Different players may play in subsequent rounds.
- c) When entries have been received a draw will be made and the teams placed into three groups. Teams from the former WGU districts 1, 2, 3 & 4 into Group A, former WGU districts 5, 6 & 9 into Group B and former WGU districts 7, 8 & 10 into Group C. The number of qualifiers for the final stages will be determined by the number of clubs entered in each group and in proportion to the number of clubs entered in the competition who have to qualify. There will be 32 teams qualifying for the finals.
- d) **PLEASE NOTE:** Any club which qualifies for the finals of this Championship but fails to play must provide the Wales Golf Championship Committee with a satisfactory written explanation. If a club fails to provide a satisfactory explanation it may result in the club, at the discretion of the Wales Golf Championship Committee, being prevented from entering the following year's event.

2. Eligibility

- a) The Championship shall be open to male golfers of all affiliated clubs to Wales Golf. Each affiliated club shall be represented by one team only.
- b) Each player must be an amateur golfer having a Competition CONGU handicap and either:
 - i) Be an adult playing member (excluding country members) or junior member of the club in compliance with the club's constitution continuously from 01 January on the year of the Championship or
 - ii) Be a life, or honorary member of the club continuously from 01 January on the year of the Championship provided that such membership is conferred in recognition of services to golf and the club in compliance with the Rules of Amateur Status.
- c) A player may only play for one club in the same year.
- d) Penalty for fielding an ineligible player; disqualification of the team.

3. Exemptions

From the 32 teams able to qualify for the finals of this Championship, there will be two automatic exemptions to the host venue and the holders.

4. Rules

- a) **Neutral Venue:** In all Preliminary Rounds, the venue shall be a neutral course to be decided by the Championship Manager, of Wales Golf and the round must be played within the stipulated time. All clubs entering this Championship must agree to make their course available as a neutral venue for the Preliminary Rounds.
- b) **Agreeing Matches:** Equal responsibility lies with both clubs regarding contact to agree matches. If no mutual agreement is reached regarding the date of any match, the Championship Manager must be informed and the match shall be played at 2.30pm on the last qualifying date. If matches are not played by the specified dates, both teams will be scratched, subject to the right of the Chairman of the Championship Committee to grant a walkover to one of them.
- c) **Order of Play:** The selected five players can play in any order that is decided by the Team Captain/Manager.
- d) **Handicap Certificates:** Each Team Captain must produce current handicap certificates for each team member if requested to do so by their opponents.
- e) **Results:** The winners of each match are to report the result immediately to the Championship Department.

- f) **Disputes:** All disputes must be referred to the Championship Manager, Wales Golf who will resolve them by use of the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the conditions of entry published in relation to this Championship. If it is not possible to resolve a dispute by the above method, the Championship Manager will place the issue before the Championship and Rules Committee and its decision shall be final.

5. Winner & Prizes

- a) The Winners of the Championship will be the Welsh Team Champions for the year and will be presented with the Championship Trophy and will receive a memento. Each individual player will also receive a memento.
- b) The Runners Up will receive a memento. Each individual player will also receive a memento.
- c) Clubs finishing in 3rd & 4th place – each player will receive a memento.
