

**Welsh Amateur Championship
Monday 29th July – Friday 2nd August

Player Information

Format

The Welsh Amateur Championship will be contested in two stages. The first stage will be 36 holes of Stroke Play, with 18 holes to be played on days 1 & 2. The top 32 will then go forward to contest the Championship in a Match Play knockout. **Ties for the final qualifying spot(s) will be decided by sudden death play-off.** Ties for all other places will be decided by card count back. All matches will be contested over 18 holes, with the exception of the final which will be 36 holes.

Registration

Online Registration will be open from Monday 22nd July at 9.00am. All players will be emailed to request confirmation of their participation. Alternatively, registration on-site will be open from 10.00am through to 4pm on Sunday 28th July or by calling 07921 300611. **ALL PLAYERS MUST REGISTER USING ONE OF THESE METHODS.**

Local Rules will be available on the Championship Noticeboard the evening of 28th July to all competitors. All other paperwork will be waiting for competitors on the 1st tee of each morning.

Tee Times

The Draw will be made no later than one week after the close of entries and will be published via email to all players. Tee times for the Matchplay stages will be published upon completion of the 2nd round and then ongoing throughout the Championship.

Handicaps

Entrants must be able to provide proof of handicap (if a valid CDH number has not already been provided) at any Wales Golf championship when requested by the committee, failure to do so may result in withdrawal from the championship.

Withdrawals

Players who are required to withdraw will need to contact the Championship Manager on 01633 436040 prior to Saturday 27th July or by using 07921300611 thereafter.

Caddies

Competitors ARE allowed caddies in this championship.



Dial-a-ref

Competitors may use a mobile phone to call the championship manager if they require assistance on the course and cannot locate a referee/WG official; 07921 300611. Other than for this purpose mobile phones (and similar devices) may not be used on the golf course (including on practice days) by players or caddies for making/sending or receiving calls or texts except in case of emergency.

Dress Code

Players are required to abide by the dress regulations of both Wales Golf and Tenby Golf Club; smart casual clothing (appropriate golf attire) must be worn in all areas of the clubhouse and on the course for the duration of the championship. No denim to be worn on the golf course during the event.

The clubhouse will be open one hour before the first tee off time on each day. Competitors, their family and guests are permitted to use the clubhouse facilities.

Catering

Catering will be available for breakfast (from one hour before the first tee off time on each day) which will include healthy options, and lunch provisions for all players during the Championship, if required. All players are required to settle their own accounts. Catering requirements will be assessed as the Matchplay stages progress, and it is possible that pre-ordering breakfast for the quarter finals and finals may be required.

Practice

The official practice round is reserved for Sunday 28th July. Tee times available are 10.00 – 12.30 & 2.00 – 4.30 and are to be booked directly with the professional shop on 01834 842978. **Note:** The finals of the Victory Shield will be taking place and priority will be given to these matches, if required.

The range will be available for competitors with tokens at £3.00 or £5.00. Players can purchase balls and/or tokens from the professional shop. There are also short game facilities available, as well as the junior pitch and putt course.

Accommodation

There is plenty of accommodation available in the surrounding areas, and any requirements are down to the individual.

Player Information

Pull trolleys are available for hire at cost of £4

Electric trolleys are available for hire at a cost of £10. There are limited number available

Course planners are available for hire at a cost of £5

Locker rooms are available for use for competitors throughout the Championship, although it is advised clubs and personal belongings are not left unattended.

Car Park

Competitors may use the main car park and/or the overflow if required. Tenby Golf Club and Wales Golf accept no responsibility for damage to cars

Presentation

The official prize presentation will commence shortly after the final has been concluded on Friday 2nd August

Volunteers & Officials

During the event there will be a number of volunteers and officials from Wales Golf and from Tenby Golf Club. These are here primarily for your safety and the enjoyment for all. If you are given an instruction from volunteers or officials, you must comply.
