SPECIFIC TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. The Championship

- a) The Championship shall be open to female amateur golfers of all nationalities.
- b) It shall be played over 36 holes. 18 holes on day one and 18 holes on day two.
- c) The Winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest score over the 36 holes. In the event of a tie, there will be a hole by hole sudden death playoff over holes to be decided by the Championship Committee.
- d) Ties for all other places will be decided by the lowest score for the final 18 holes (or last 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s) in turn as required). If a tie still exists, a hole-by-hole card playoff starting from hole 1 will be used.
- e) A maximum of 120 competitors shall play in the Championship.
- f) Each player will also be placed in an age group category, according to their age on day 1 of the Championship, to play for the prizes outlined in 4e) below. The age categories are:

A: 50-54

B: 55-59

C: 60-64

D: 65-69

E: 70+

2. Entry Qualifications

- a) Entries will only be accepted from players with a Competition CONGU Handicap of 20.4 or less or overseas equivalent.
- b) Entrants holding both a Competition CONGU Handicap and an overseas handicap must enter this Championship using their Competition CONGU handicap.
- c) All entrants must be 50 years of age or over on day 1 of the Championship.
- d) Failure to enter in accordance with this condition will result in entry being denied.

3. Exemptions

None

4. Winner & Prizes

- a) The winner of the Championship will be the Welsh Open Senior Ladies' Champion for the year and will be presented with the Championship Cup and will receive a memento.
- b) The Runner Up will be presented with the Judy Ray Salver and will receive a memento.
- c) The 3rd placed competitor will receive a memento.
- d) The highest placed Welsh competitor will be the Welsh Senior Ladies' Champion for the year and will be presented with the Diana Pritchard Salver and will receive a memento.
- e) The best net score over 36 holes in each Age Group will receive a memento

NB The winner, runner up and 3rd placed players in the Welsh Open Senior Ladies Championship and the highest placed Welsh competitor (Welsh Senior Ladies Champion) will not be eligible to win an age group prize.
