3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

(a) Membership

The minimum number of members in a club applying for affiliation is 20 full subscription paying adult members and the minimum annual subscription shall be £500 pa (see Wales Golf Rules 2.3)

The club agrees to comply with the Articles and Rules of Wales Golf.

(b) Constitution

To be eligible for membership of Wales Golf a club must have a Constitution and Rules appropriate to a golf club and to a standard acceptable to Wales Golf. **(A copy of the Club's Constitution and Rules must be included with this application).**

(c) Child Protection Policy

It is mandatory for every club wishing to affiliate to Wales Golf to provide a fit for purpose Child Protection Policy, which should be displayed on your Club's notice board and ideally on your Club's website. **(A copy of the Club's Child Protection Policy must be included with this application).** A standard template is available from Wales Golf on request.

(d) Central Database of Handicaps (CDH)

It is a condition of membership to Wales Golf that each club uploads their membership details to the CHD, maintains and keeps details up to date. **This information must be uploaded within one month of membership to Wales Golf.**

(e) Subscriptions

In accordance with Wales Golf's Rules, each Club shall pay Subscription Fees annually on the following basis: -

- i) In respect of every Adult Member on 31st March or at the time of application at the current rate of £14.20.**
An adult playing member is anyone aged 18 or over on 1 January 2019 with the right to play over the club's designated course(s) regardless of whether they choose to hold a handicap.
- ii) In respect of every Junior Member on 31st March or at the time of application at the current rate of £4.50.**
A junior playing member is anyone aged under 18 on 1 January 2019 with the right to play over the club's designated course(s) regardless of whether they choose to hold a handicap.
- iii) The total minimum annual Subscription Fee payable by a Club is £500 pa.**

(f) Change of Governing Authority

Any change of Governing Authority of a course (or club) through sale or any other reason must be notified to Wales Golf. Continued affiliation will not be automatic and will only be confirmed by Wales Golf if and when it is satisfied that the clubs constitution shall remain unchanged or if changed will still comply with all the mandatory requirements as laid down in Part 3 of this form.

(g) Playing Facilities

A club not controlling a course must have permission from the golf club, person or body controlling the course to make reasonable playing facilities available each week and containing adequate arrangements for all members to play a minimum of four Qualifying Competitions per annum during the months of April to October. (If relevant such permission must be included with this application for affiliation).

(h) Rules of Golf and Rules of Amateur Status

The club shall abide by the Rules of Golf and the Rules of Amateur Status as laid down from time to time by the R&A.

(i) Handicapping

The club agrees to comply with the Council of National Golf Union's Regulations and Rules of the CONGU Unified Handicapping System (and any conditions imposed within the scheme by Wales Golf).

Handicapping Records must be available for inspection under the terms of clause 4.3 of the CONGU Unified Handicapping Scheme at reasonable notice.

(j) Courses for Union Events

Every club in membership of Wales Golf shall agree to offer its course and clubhouse for the holding of Union meetings or for the events managed by Wales Golf when called upon to do so by the Council.
