

## Level 1 & 2 Coaching Criteria

Detailed guidance on the essential requirements for each level of coaching qualification is for levels 1 and 2 contained within the relevant 'Qualification Specifications' document. A summary of the key requirements is shown below:

<b>Qualification Title</b>	ASQ Level 1 certificate in Coaching Golf	ASQ Level 2 certificate in Coaching Golf
<b>Level Descriptor</b>	Assist more qualified coaches, delivering aspects of coaching sessions normally under direct supervision	Prepare for, deliver and review coaching sessions
<b>Learning Hours</b>	40 hours (including home study time)	80 hours (including home study time)
<b>Course Structure</b>	2 consecutive days plus an evening of preparation in between (includes assessment)	4 taught days plus 2 assessment days, spread over a period of 6 months
<b>Tutor to Coach ratio</b>	Maximum 1:8	Maximum 1:8
<b>Tutor criteria</b>	Tutors must have completed PGA Tutor Training programme and the appropriate course orientation	
<b>Running a Course</b>	A course for 8 must have 6 candidates to run A Course for 16 must have 12 candidates to run	
<b>Entry requirements</b>	Minimum age 16	Minimum age 16 plus a level 1 certificate in Coaching Golf
<b>Ability requirements</b>	No minimum handicap although throughout the delivery of this qualification. However candidates will be required to demonstrate and apply the correct technical models for the full range of applicable shots. This means that candidates will need to demonstrate an appropriate level of ability.
