



WELSH UNDER 14 CHAMPIONSHIP 2020

SPECIFIC TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. The Championship

- a) The Championship shall be open to male amateur golfers who meet the criteria set out below in section 2.
- b) The Championship shall be decided by 36 holes of stroke play. The winner will be the player who returns the lowest gross score over 36 holes
- c) Male and female competitors will play from separate teeing grounds. Where possible teeing grounds will be set so that the par & SSS for male competitors will be the same as the par and SSS for female competitors. In the event of different SSS ratings for male and female competitors, an adjustment will be made to the gross scores of either the male or female competitors as appropriate to adjust for the difference in SSS
- d) In the event of a tie for first place, a hole by hole sudden death playoff will commence shortly following the conclusion of the final group
- e) A maximum of 84 players will compete in the combined Under 16 & Under 14 Championships. Each of the two age categories will be limited to 42 players. However if one of the events is undersubscribed whilst the other is oversubscribed the number of players competing in the oversubscribed event may be increased subject to the overall number of players in the two events not exceeding 84 and the number of players in the U14 Championship not exceeding 64.

2. Entry Qualifications

- a) Entries will only be accepted from players who can meet one of the following criteria requirements:
 - i) Born in Wales;
 - ii) One of your parents was born in Wales;
 - iii) One of your grandparents was born in Wales;
 - iv) Resided in Wales for two years prior to day 1 of the Championship
- b) Entrants MUST NOT have played in the Men's or Ladies Closed Championship of another country within the last two years (e.g. in 2018 or 2019) or have ever played in the full International Team of another country.
- c) Entries will only be accepted from players who were under 14 years of age at 00:00hrs on 1st January 2020.
- d) Entries will only be accepted from players with a Competition CONGU handicap of 28.4 or less or overseas equivalent.
- e) Entrants holding both a Competition CONGU Handicap and an overseas handicap must enter this Championship using their Competition CONGU handicap.
- f) A player who is eligible to enter the Under 14 Championship (played on the same day at the same venue) may choose to enter the Under 16 Championship instead if their handicap does not exceed 20.4 but may not play in both.
- g) Failure to enter in accordance with this condition will result in entry being denied.

3. Exemptions

4. Winner & Prizes

- a) The winner of the Under 14 Championship will be the Welsh Under 14 Champion for the year and will be presented with the Championship Cup and will receive a memento.
- b) The Runner Up in the Under 14 Championship will receive a memento.
- c) The person finishing in 3rd place in the Under 14 Championship will receive a memento.
- d) The leading girl, boy and nett score during the Championships will all receive a memento
