<b>Format</b>	54 holes. 18 holes on day one, 18 holes on day two and the top 60 and ties will qualify to play 18 holes on day three.
<b>Tee Times</b>	Rounds 1 and 2 published via GolfBox no later than Friday 17 <sup>th</sup> June. Round 3 will be published after the completion of round 2. Players will go out in reverse standing order. Tee times when published can be found <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>Registration</b>	Online Registration will open Wednesday 15 <sup>th</sup> June.

<b>Practice Round</b>	Tuesday 21 <sup>st</sup> June 10am - 4.30pm. Practice rounds are to be booked with the club on 02920701185 #3 or via the professional shop.
<b>Practice Facilities</b>	4 nets, putting and chipping green onsite. Wedges on the practice area only where players must hit their own balls. Closest driving range is St Andrews Major, 15 minutes from the course.
<b>Caddies &amp; Spectators</b>	Caddies are permitted. Spectators welcome.
<b>Catering</b>	Open 1 hour prior to the start of each day's play for breakfast, lunch and dinner each day. At player's own expense.
<b>Clubhouse &amp; Pro Shop</b>	Open 1 hour prior to the start of each day's play.

Prizes are also awarded to Runner Up and third placed competitors. Age Group Prizes (gross scores) to the competitor with the lowest gross score over 54 holes in their age group.
