## **Competitor Information**

### **Format**

Those in the Under 8s, Under 10s & Under 12s age groups will play **10** holes of modified stableford.

The Under 14s category will play an 18 hole stableford competition.

Each age group will have their own specific teeing ground to use for their round. Full information will be available on the day at the Championship Office and from the Starter.

### **Registration**

All players and accompanying adults must register in the Championship Office on site at Mold Golf Club at least 30-60 minutes prior to their tee time. The Championship Office will be in the Junior Room, first door on the right when you enter the clubhouse and will be clearly signposted.

### **Parents and Supporters**

It is a requirement that all competitors are accompanied by a parent/guardian whilst at the event.

Information for parents/guardians and supporters will be given out at the Championship Office when the player registers.

### **Withdrawals**

### **Accommodation**

There is plenty of accommodation in Mold. There are also lots of other towns nearby for accommodation, including Wrexham (30min drive), Chester (35min drive) and Prestatyn (40min drive).

## **Dress Code**

Smart casual clothing is expected for all. No denim trousers to be worn during the event.

## **Practice Facilities**

There is a 4 bay covered driving range on site by the 12<sup>th</sup> hole, with a private car park containing an access code. Players need to use their own balls on the range.

There are two practice nets by the putting green which is located by the overflow car park behind the 18<sup>th</sup> green. There are two short game areas on site; one located between the 4<sup>th</sup> green and 5<sup>th</sup> tee, and a second located to the right of the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole.

More detailed information on all of the practice facilities is available in the document accompanying this in the email, including directions to the practice range and the access code.

## **Practice**

There is no official practice day for this event, however those that may be staying overnight may find it best to practice in the afternoon of Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> April. Those that wish to have a practice round on any other day may do so. In both cases practice rounds are to be booked by phoning either the manager on 01352 741513 or the pro shop on 01352 740318. Please quote Ping Junior Tour Event 1 when booking.

## **Trolleys**

There are 4 pull trolleys available for hire at a cost of £5 each and 1 electric trolleys for hire at £10 each. Should you wish to hire a trolley it is recommended that you pre-book through Mold GC pro shop on 01352 740318.

## **Catering**

The clubhouse and catering will be available from 7:00am for breakfast, thereafter catering will be available at the club throughout the day until the end of the event. Please note the catering is separate from the bar.

## **Presentations**

Presentations for each age group will take place once all players in that age group have completed their rounds. Golf clothing will be suitable attire for the presentations. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed players in each category and the leading female and male player in each category.

Presentations will take place in the seating area of the clubhouse.

## **Volunteers & Officials**

There will be a number of volunteers and officials from Wales Golf and Mold Golf Club present at the event.

They are here primarily for your safety and to ensure the smooth running of the competition. Please follow any instructions you are given by Wales Golf/Mold GC representatives whilst at the event.

## **Video & Photography**

Video filming and photography may take place at the event on behalf of Wales Golf consistent with Wales Golf's photography policy. There is provision for consent within the parental consent forms, however if you have any reservations please contact the Championship Office. If any other person wishes to take photographs at the event (other than of their own child) they must obtain prior permission from Wales Golf.

## **Parental Consent Forms**

Completed Parental Consent Forms and adherence to the Parental Code of Conduct are a requirement for this event.
