

# New2Golf Beginner Scheme 2023 - Criteria

This scheme aims to assist clubs in recruiting new members and funds a Golf Professional to deliver 6 beginner group lessons for potential members. Wales Golf will fund up to 3 beginner groups per year (of the club's choice e.g. women, juniors), with additional funding available for junior girl's groups and disability groups.

#### **CHANGES FOR 2023**

- Wales Golf will fund beginner sessions at the new rate of £30 p.h. (£180 per group)
- With the help of your regional development officer, your club will be set up on the new online participant booking platform
- Wales Golf can provide each club with one paid social media advert (max £30)

#### **SCHEME ESSENTIALS**

#### **SAFEGUARDING:**

All clubs must be **SafeGolf** accredited to ensure that the club environment is safe for young people playing the sport. The club must:-

- ✓ Have a child and adult safeguarding policy in place
- ✓ Have a Junior Organiser who is DBS checked and attended a Safeguarding and Protecting Children Workshop (all other volunteers helping within the junior section will also need to have DBS and SPC)
- ✓ PGA Professional(s) delivering the coaching sessions **MUST** be on the SafeGolf Accredited Coaches list on the SafeGolf website (so have a current DBS check and have attended and SPC course)
- ✓ Have a Club Welfare Officer who has attended an SPC and Time to Listen workshop

#### **GENERAL:**

- ✓ Your application **must** be approved by Wales Golf **BEFORE** the lessons start
- ✓ Participants must be non-members (or those who have just newly joined the club and are beginners).
- ✓ Group sizes must be a minimum of 8.
- ✓ The safety of the participants, coaches and volunteers is paramount and the club and coach must conduct a risk assessment prior to each session.
- ✓ Each participant will receive a New2Golf pack including discount vouchers (these will be sent to the club prior to the start of the scheme)
- ✓ The club must have a scheme organiser in addition to the Professional
- ✓ All New2Golf participants will be entered into the Wales Golf Clubhouse, World Handicapping System (WHS) in a separate New2Golf area. This will create a CDH number for the participant which can be activated by the club when the participant joins.

## AN IDEAL BEGINNER SCHEME WILL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- ✓ Using existing members to promote scheme as well as promoting in the local community.
- ✓ A free taster session for the beginners wanting to try golf prior to signing up to the lessons
- ✓ Representatives from the club (or section) involved in organising and supporting the sessions
- $\checkmark$  An offer of continuation group lessons to enable ongoing progression (e.g. a further 6 weeks for £30). These should be self-funded by the participants or subsidised by the club.
- ✓ Fun beginner competitions / introduction to golf course

- ✓ Promotion of the Wales Golf New2Golf Summer Swing competitions
- The club/facility MUST offer some form of trial membership for those who have participated in the scheme to encourage them to join (e.g. £20/30 for 2 months). During this, members should make the new participants feel welcome, gradually introduce them to the course (e.g. a mentoring scheme, fun comps), familiarise them with the rules/etiquette and invite them to social events. - ✓ Clubs should offer a menu of membership options (post trial membership) to suit different lifestyles. E.g. flexible, lifestyle, family, academy
- ✓ Clubs should consider supporting new members through mentoring and lessons for at least 3 years to aid improvement

# **APPLICATION AND CLAIMS PROCESS**

- 1. Email Sarah Lewis: sarah.lewis@walesgolf.org for an online application form.
- 2. Once approved, you will receive a confirmation email and links to the necessary resources.
- 3. Arrange a planning session with your Development Officer who will set your club up on the online booking platform
- 4. New2Golf membership packs will be sent out on receipt of the above and must to be distributed ASAP.
- 5. After the 6 weeks are completed, return the claim form and await payment.
