As outlined, if a player meets the eligibility criteria to apply, **this does not guarantee selection**.

IMPORTANT NOTES

All players must complete the online application form in order to be considered for selection. Players who were a member of a 2022/23 Performance programmes will not automatically be considered.

Selection decisions are at the discretion of the Wales Golf High Performance Selection Group, and will be based on numerous factors, including those outlined below ...

- Performance Criteria this determines a players' eligibility to apply Players U18 must strictly meet these minimum standards in order to be considered
- Performance Data
 - Stroke averages in Key Events
 - Finishing places in Key Events
 - Matchplay Records
- Performance Indicators
 - WAGR movement (from 01/03 01/09)
 - Handicap record (without inclusion of supplementary scores)
 - Number of scores counting for Handicap in current year

Overseas players wishing to apply must state they are overseas in their application.

If you are unable to fully commit to the programme or attendance at squad sessions, **please state the reason why on your application**, as you may still be offered appropriate support.

YOUR COMMITMENT

Successful applicants will be asked to comply and commit to the items listed below and the behaviours in the Player Agreement document (sent with offer letter).

All successful players MUST be committed and agree to the items below.

- Attendance at the Squad Introduction and Data Collection weekend
- To arrive on time to every session, workshop and/or meeting
- Meet every deadline set by the Wales Golf High Performance Team
- To enter and play in the Wales Golf Open Strokeplay and the age group championship in 2024 (if eligible).
- Be available for selection and nomination to play for Wales.
- Players will be expected to maintain the Wales Golf High Performance Code of Behaviours at all times
- Players will be monitored on an ongoing basis in terms of their attitude and adherence
- Players will be expected to fully commit and engage in all Squad sessions

HIGH PERFORMANCE

Players receive holistic performance plan based on individual needs with access to the Wales Golf Performance Team, tournament opportunities and funding to enable podium successes and support towards the next step in their golfing careers

OVER 18

Players receive support based on commitment and delivery of an agreed performance plan, performance workshops to enhance learning and progression, opportunities and funding for players to compete in appropriate international events and work towards entry into High Performance squad

UNDER 18

Players receive support in designing and delivering an agreed performance plan, performance training squads based on squad needs to enhance learning and progression to work towards entry into over18's squad and team representation

UNDER 16

Players receive support in designing, delivering and monitoring of a performance plan, maintaining and developing technical skills and tournament processes, performance training squads to enhance learning and progression to work towards entry into under18's squad and team representation
