



Minimum length of a golf course to be eligible for a Course and Slope Rating

Until recently, before a golf course was eligible for a WHS™ Course and Slope Rating, the minimum length that a golf course needed to measure was 3,000 yards (1,500 yards for a 9-hole course).

We are pleased to advise that the minimum length has now been reduced to 1,500 yards for an 18-hole golf course and 750 yards for a 9-hole golf course. This will allow scores to be acceptable for handicap purposes over more golf courses and make it easier for more players to obtain a Handicap Index®.
